While in college, Coach Joseph was a three year starter for the University of Northern Colorado wrestling team. After college, he started coaching at the high school level. Coach Joseph was the head coach at Palmer Ridge High School in Monument, CO, from 2008 to 2012. In the last two seasons under Coach Joseph's direction, Palmer Ridge had thirteen state qualifiers and five state placers. In 2009, Coach Joseph started the 7352 School of Wrestling, an advanced freestyle and Greco-Roman club for youth and high school wrestlers in the Colorado Springs area. In 2012, Coach Joseph became an assistant coach at Broomfield High School in Broomfield, CO. In 2013, Broomfield won the 4A Colorado state title as well as the Top of the Rockies tournament to establish itself as the best team in Colorado during that season. From 2009 to 2013, Coach Joseph was also a board member and junior national team coach for Colorado USA Wrestling. In the fall of 2013, Coach Joseph left high school coaching and returned to college where he was a volunteer alumni coach for Northern Colorado. In 2014, Coach Joseph moved to Stillwater, Oklahoma, where he was an assistant coach for Stillwater High School, which was ranked as high as 10th in the nation. Stillwater won the 2015 Oklahoma dual state title and had five athletes go on to wrestle at the NCAA Division I level.

In addition to coaching, Coach Joseph has been blessed to have had the unique opportunity to study and learn from some of the greatest college and Olympic coaches in the world while spending time at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs as well as the Cowboy Wrestling Club at Oklahoma State University. Coach Joseph also has volunteer experience working at high level wrestling events such as the NCAA Championships, the U.S. Olympic Trials, and the World Championships. He is a USA Wrestling Bronze certified coach.
