Friday

3:00pm – Wrestlers will begin to arrive through the Delaware Street Media Entrance.

Coolers must be kept at the lower level. Coolers are not to go up into the stands. Please have wrestlers bring their coolers because parents will not be able to bring them in when they arrive.

3:30 - 4:25pm - Wrestlers able to check weight.

4:30 - Weigh-ins in Locker Rooms 1-4

4:30 - 4:45pm - Coach's meeting in the Practice Gymnasium. (Assistant Commissioner and Supervisor of Officials)

5:00pm – Doors open for general public

5:30pm – Wrestlers will be in line for the walk-in.

Line up in Practice Gymnasium alphabetical by school

5:45pm - Coach's Association Representatives will lead the wrestlers in the "Parade of Champions"

During the walk-around, have your team stay somewhat in a single file line. Walk on the outside of the mats until you get to where you came in, then go onto the floor (to Mr. Fleming), then walk in your line on the mats. Please try and stay in single file line!!! Once everybody has stopped, the National Anthem will be performed. After the National Anthem, we will clear the mats to wrestle.

5:55pm -Singing the "National Anthem": Melina DeGolyer from Tri-West Hendricks

6:00pm - Wrestle First Round

During wrestling, listen for times when the weigh-in room will be open for wrestlers to check their weight. This will be provided as a service. They will only be open for 10-15 minutes each time it opens.

10:00pm - First round ends.

8:30 – Weigh-ins for wrestlers

8:30am – Doors open for general public

9:30am - Begin wrestling Second Round

Third Round (Semi-Finals) will be wrestled immediately after Second Round

2:30pm (approx.) - The Arena will be cleared.

All wrestlers and coaches must either leave the arena totally or be back in the locker rooms. Please stay out of the main hallway!!!

4:00pm - Doors for spectators will open again for Consolations and Finals

4:45pm - Consolation Round will be wrestled

6:50pm (approx.) - Coaches meet with Mr. Minch and Assistant Commissioner Robert Faulkens at center mat.

We will discuss the line-up method. Upper bracket wrestlers will be at one end of Fieldhouse in weight class order, and the lower bracket wrestlers will do the same at the other end. Coaches will be lined up on each side of the mat (please be off the mat itself). When announced, the wrestler will walk to the center of the outside edge of the mat and meet his coach. After both wrestlers are announced, the coaches will go back to their position in line, and the wrestlers will cross over, shaking hands with his opponent at center mat. The wrestlers will then stand on the edge of the mat. Please have the wrestlers stay close together. When the 152-pound wrestlers cross over and shake hands, they need to leave about a 5-foot space between them and the 145-pound wrestler so wrestlers can walk between them to get introduced.

7:00pm – Introductions of contestants from each end of the Fieldhouse

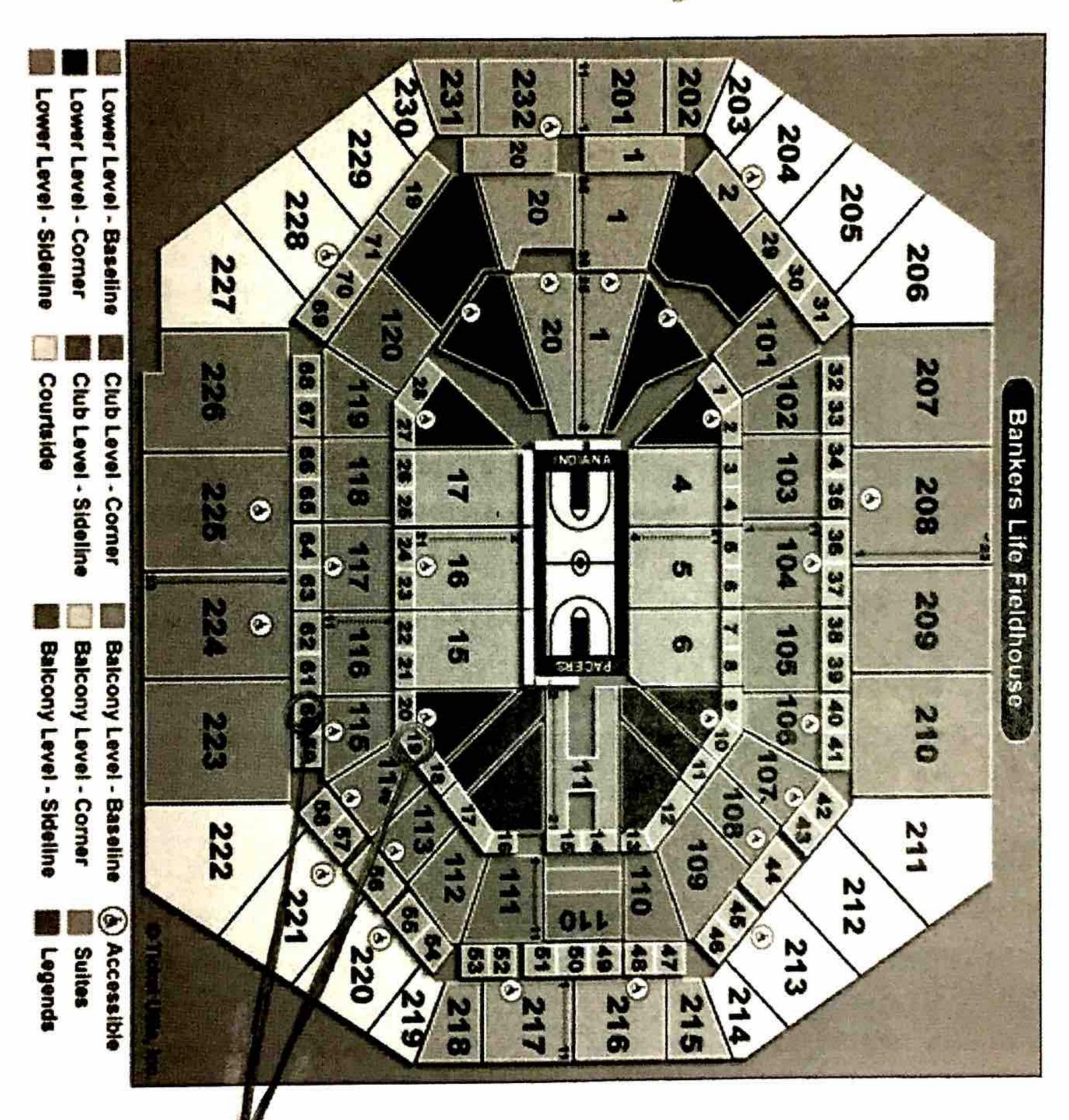
